Work has continued since the quarterly update sent out in October, 2013. The following report contains highlights of the progress being made and the continued planning to move Interprofessional Education and meeting the Triple Aim forward in South Dakota. The following is an update on Dr. Brandt's recommendations:

1. Prepare a report from the raw summit data.

- a. Data from the table discussions has been organized in themes.
- b. A report from the summit proceedings was submitted to Dr. Barbara Brandt in early December for her inclusion in her national report to the RWJ Foundation. The writing team consisted of Carla Dieter (USD Nursing), Deb Letcher (Nursing-Sanford), Barb Brockevelt (USD-OT), and Melissa Alexander (USD-PA), and Janet Philipp (Augustana-Nursing).
- c. The report writers will also work with Dr. Brandt in publishing a journal article.

2. Select the groups that will serve the project and move the work forward

- a. In review, summit participants self-identified their desired level of involvement going forward. The three categories were a) keep me informed; b) Action Strategies sub-committee; and c) Structure Team. Many checked all three areas. The summit planning committee reviewed the responses and selected members of the structure team to gain a broad representation of members from practice, public and private education, and disciplines. Email invitations were sent out to confirm continued interest in the structure team. A *draft* of the organizational chart is included and lists the members of the Structure Team and Advisory Council. (see attachment)
- b. The Structure Team met for the first time on November 2 and divided responsibilities to draft a name of the group, a statement for a purpose and shared vision of the group, responsibilities of the Structure Team, Advisory council, and Action Strategy sub-committees. Draft criteria for selection of action strategies and how the flow of requests for projects will occur.
- c. The Structure Team met for the second time January 22, 2014 to discuss the draft work of the group. Feedback was given to each workgroup and additional work will be done and brought back to the next meeting scheduled for March 26, 2014.
- d. Discussions of possible statewide projects involving the Institute of Healthcare Improvement (IHI) student group and the IHI modules were discussed.

- e. Those who put 'keep me informed' will continue to receive the planned quarterly updates. Further involvement is always encouraged and would be welcome if there is a project or initiative that you feel you can contribute to at a deeper level.

3. Name the project going forward to create identity

- a. Possible names were discussed at the January meeting with group feedback and the goal is to have the group named by the end of the March meeting.

4. Continued involvement with Dr. Brandt

- a. Dr. Brandt will continue to be involved with our group as a coach. We are very fortunate to have someone of her stature to mentor us. Her knowledge and expertise will be invaluable as we advance IPE in South Dakota.

5. Select projects to showcase and to highlight going forward and support

- a. The workgroup is moving forward with developing a method to gain more information regarding statewide IPE activities. Criteria for selection of statewide projects will follow.
